Contemporary theories of museology emphasize the role of learning departments and educators in shaping modern cultural institutions. The litmus test of these theories is the daily practice of educators, including their involvement in the designing of exhibitions and temporary projects.

This meeting aims to analyse how historical residences, custodians of national heritage, respond to the needs of the contemporary audience that is from a templum-type institution to a modern and open museum in order to to strengthen the educational potential of historical residences.
